

# Château Du Tailhas

## Pomerol

*The wine shows a floral nose with notes of ripe fruits and underbrush.*

**GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION:** Château du Tailhas is on the southern slopes of the Pomerol plateau, bordering on the commune of Saint-Emilion to the east.

**HISTORY:** a land patent of 1289 from Edward 1st- king of the English and Aquitaine- set the limit between Pomerol and Saint Emilion to the stream of Tailhayat at the origins of the name of the wine. Acquired in 1932 by Philippe Neboit, the estate has been run by his heirs since 1981.

**SURFACE AREA:** 11 ha

**SOIL:** Siliceous soil mixed of fine gravel, desbudding

**GRAPE VARIETIES:** 80 % Merlot, 10 % Cabernet-Franc, 10 % Cabernet Sauvignon.

**DENSITY OF PLANTATION:** 6000 vines/ha

**AVERAGE AGE OF THE VINES:** 35 years-old

**HARVESTING:** Harvested by hand. Natural grass growing between the rows, De-leafing, De-budding, sustainable viticulture (Label Terra Vitis).

**VINIFICATION:** Traditional vinification in cement and stainless-steel vat with the thermoregulation with 21-28 days of maceration. Cold prefermentary maceration.

**AGEING:** During 12 to 18 months in Barrels, 50 % new oak, 50 % French merrain oak.
