

Château Grand Pey Lescours

Saint Emilion Grand Cru

*A supple and generous wine with a great finesse and nice black-fruit and underground notes
Pleasant to drink from now but it will be better when ageing*

LOCATION : This previous property of Baronne Arthur de Brezets, bought in 1924 by the family Escure, is located in St Sulpice de Faleyrens. The arrival of Jean-Marie Bouldy, owner of Ch. Bellegrave in Pomerol and of the young generation Escure brought new ideas to valorise this estate, like what it is done at the Ch. Bellisle Mondotte, the Escure's estate and at the Ch. Bellegrave

VINEYARD AREA : 25.60 hectares

SOIL : Gravely and sandy with a sub-soil showing tracks of iron hardpan.

GRAPE VARIETIES : 70% Merlot, 25% cabernet franc, 5% cabernet sauvignon

Age of the vines: 25

HARVESTING : Desbudding, deleafing. Hand-picking with sorting out at the cellar

WINEMAKING : Traditional winemaking in thermo regulated stainless steel vats with a 3-week-maceration

AGEING : In stainless steel vats and oak barrels during 20 months
