

# Château Jeanguillon

## Les Vignes de La Garène

### Entre Deux Mers

*Beautiful white-green-tinted wine with very elegant fruity aromas.  
To taste fresh at 8-12°C. over seashells.*

**LOCATION:** Located in the district of Soussac, in the heart of the Entre Deux Mers sur le haut plateau de la ligne de partage des eaux entre Dordogne and Garonne , the domaine of Le Caillou has belonged to the family Pommier since 1863. For 2 years, it has been run by Kristel de Meillac, daughter of Mrs Pommier and his husband Philippe de Meillac. The house, located in the midst of the vines of Jeanguillon, dates back 1656 and was renovated over the last two years.

**VINEYARD AREA :** 85 hectares out of which 35 hectares of white

**SOIL :** Clayey-calcareous

**GRAPE VARIETIES:** 40% Sauvignon, 30% Sauvignon gris, 20% Sémillon, 10% Muscadelle

Average age of the vines: 25

**HARVESTING:** Integrated agriculture with no pesticides and fertilizers and limited yields. Mechanised harvesting with double sorting out in the vines and in the cellar.

**WINEMAKING :** Cold skin maceration, fermentation in stainless steel vats with temperature monitoring.

**AGEING :** Bottling in the first two months of the year to preserve freshness.
