

Château Lalande Borie

Saint Julien Cru Bourgeois

*A meaty, well-balanced and elegant wine with loads of fruit and ripe tannins
To taste at 17°C on grilled red meats, game and cheeses*

LOCATION: Estate located in St Julien De Beychevelle, created in 1970 from the gathering of vines of a third growth and left to Mr Jean Eugène Borie, owner of Ducru Beaucaillou

VINEYARD AREA: 22 hectares

SOIL: Light-gravels covering a subsoil of coarse pebbles and clay.

GRAPE VARIETIES: 65% Cabernet Sauvignon – 25% Merlot -
10% Cabernet Franc

Average age of the Vineyard: 25

HARVESTING: Hand-Picking at full ripeness. Sorting out in the vines on mobile tables.

WINEMAKING: . Traditional winemaking with a 3-week-vatting in cement vats with temperature monitoring.

AGEING: In oak barrels of which 30% are new.
