

# Château Sénéjac

## Haut-Médoc Cru Bourgeois

*Beautiful deep purple colour- A very intense nose of black fruits and spices.  
The mouth is rich, full and velvety  
It is a charming and elegant wine which is pleasant to drink in its early age.*

**LOCATION:** On the plateau of Le Pian on beautiful slopes.

The vine was first planted in the 16th century. It was owned by the Marechal d'Ornano in the 19th century and was bought in 1860 by Comte de Guigné. A new impulse to make it one of the best growths of the Medoc is now given Mr et Mme Rustmann who bought the estate recently.

**VINEYARD AREA:** 30 hectares

**SOIL:** Gravelly

**GRAPE VARIETIES:** 56 % Cabernet Sauvignon - 36 % Merlot - 7% Cabernet Franc - 1% Petit Verdot

Age of the vines: 35

**HARVESTING:** Green harvest, leaf removals- Hand-picking at full ripeness  
– Sorting out in the vines and in the cellar

**WINEMAKING:** Traditional methods in thermo regulated stainless steel vats. Pumping-over twice a day. Malo-lactic fermentation for 30% in oak barrels

**AGEING:** During 12 to 15 months in barrels renewed by third every year.

**ANNUAL PRODUCTION:** 100 000 bottles per year.

Yields: 45 hl/ha
